

ABOUT THE RESIDENCY

There is no fee for the residency.

The Studios encourages Residency Artists to use their time in Key West to experiment, develop new ideas, learn new skills, and interact with fellow resident artists and the community. It should be a time of rich exploration for Residency Artists, and we, as the staff, will help in whatever way we can to assist you.

We ask all artists in residence to participate in two events during their residency: **A community meet and greet** for the artists in residence (AIR), and our monthly Walk on White/AIR open house (3rd Thursday of each month).

TRANSPORTATION

- Transportation to and from The Studios is the financial and logistical responsibility of each artist.
- Street parking is available for vehicles but is not guaranteed.
- Each artist will be provided with a bicycle, lights and lock, free of charge.

ACCOMMODATIONS, GROCERIES & MATERIALS

- * Housing is provided to the artist only. **OVERNIGHT GUESTS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**
- We can recommend nearby accommodations for any individuals who may visit you during your residency.
- Artists are housed in one of our four residency spaces surrounding The Studios' Sculpture Garden. All artists will have their own private bathroom and bedroom/work space, access to full kitchen facilities, laundry room and an outside deck that is shared by all.
- Groceries and provisions are the responsibility of each resident. Please be aware that the price of food (i.e. groceries and eating out) are higher in Key West than on the mainland. Please plan accordingly.
- Personal materials and equipment (i.e. art supplies, computers, printers) are the responsibility of each resident.
- Clean sheets and towels are provided. A washer and dryer is available on the campus for use during your residency.
- Smoking is not permitted in any building.
